u-xplore interactive is a highly engaging and motivating online resource which provides young people with an insight into the world of work and links students to the business community. It inspires young people to become involved in thinking about their own future and presents this through rich media such as video clips, moving graphic and 360° virtual interactive tours. It is ideal to support a cross-curricular approach to Work-Related Learning, Enterprise, Careers Education, Employability Skills and Employer Engagement.

To access u-xplore interactive, staff register in the same way as students. It's a very quick and easy process:

- You need to access the internet and type in [www.u-xplore.com](http://www.u-xplore.com)
- You will be taken to a launch page - click the icon to enter.
- On the username and password page click to create your own account. 
- Enter your details (Note for **staff** - dates of birth only go back as far as 1988)
- The School Code is your School Centre Number: **44162**
- Press Continue and create your own username and password. This can be anything you wish, although it may be best to urge your students to register using their School Network username and password, so it's easier for them to remember. You then use this username and password every time you log on in the future.
- When redirected to the start page, enter your details and press **GO!**



The **School Management Suite** is the teacher's website which sits behind the main student interface. It captures student data for monitoring and tracking purposes.
